10/25/2013 Timothy J. Rusch, Forest Co Surveyor File # 341335-20131025 indicates a found aluminum capped monument.

10/07/2025 I found and accepted a 1-1/4" dia. iron pipe with a Kimberly Clark Corp 4" dia. aluminum cap stamped to identify the corner 4" above grade along with two existing bearing trees. I made two additional bearing trees to witness the corner as shown below.


