

07/24/1972 Thomas R. Arnott, Forest Co Surveyor File # 341314-19720724 indicates he found an iron pipe.

10/10/2001 Robert O. Kamps, Forest County Certified Survey Map Vol. 6, Pg. 54 shows a found 1" dia. iron pipe w/4" Al Cap.

04/07/2025 I found and accepted a 1-1/4" dia. iron pipe with a Kimberly Clark Corp 4" dia. aluminum cap stamped to identify the corner flush with the ground in a swamp along with one of Sperhake's bearing trees which is now dead. I made four new bearing trees to witness the corner as shown below.
