

11/01/1963 Restoration of Lost Original Government Survey Corner by Neal Sperhake indicates he set a 1" dia. iron pipe with a Kimberly Clark Corp aluminum cap by local testimony and original Hemlock stump remains and made two bearing trees. (See corner form for prior history and additional information).

07/22/1977 William F Kelly, Forest Co Surveyor File # 341323-19770122 shows a symbol for the corner, but does not indicate what it is.

08/12/1977 William F. Kelly, Forest County Certified Survey Map Vol. 2, Pg. 182 found a 4" aluminum cap on iron pipe.

10/22/2004 Michael A. Treml, Forest Co Surveyor File # 341323-20041022 indicates an existing 1" dia. iron pipe w/4" alum cap.

09/18/2009 Michael A. Treml, Forest Co Surveyor File # 341323-20090918 indicates an existing 1" dia. iron pipe w/4" alum cap.

05/23/2011 Timothy J. Rusch, Forest County Certified Survey Map Vol. 8 Pg. 155 found an aluminum capped iron pipe.

01/05/2023 Timothy J. Rusch. Forest Co Surveyor File # 341325-2023105 found an aluminum capped monument.

10/07/2025 I found and accepted a 1-1/4" dia. iron pipe with a Kimberly Clark Corp 4" dia. aluminum cap stamped to identify the corner 12' above grade at the corner location. Both of Sperhake's bearing trees are gone. I made four new bearing trees to witness the corner as shown below.
