

May 7, 2025 - I found a 2.4" diameter iron pipe with a 2.4" diameter brass cap stamped to identify the corner location. The monument is on the west face of a hill, ±15 east of a woods road centerline, and extends ±36" above grade. I also found 3 of Arnott's bearing trees alive and in good condition. I established 1 new reference monuments as shown below.

A-E 7.08(3)(e) 1865 Surveyor set a post, 1975 Surveyor found a "2" iron pipe 5' long with a brass cap set by C.E. Walker in 1940", 2004 Surveyor found similar. In 2025, I found a 2.4" diameter iron pipe with a 2.4" diameter brass cap stamped C.E. Walker 1940.

A-E 7.08(3)(f) I accept this monument in good faith as a FOUND PERPETUATED LOCATION of the corner. A-E 7.08(3)(g)(h) This corner was not determined through lost-corner-proportionate methods.
