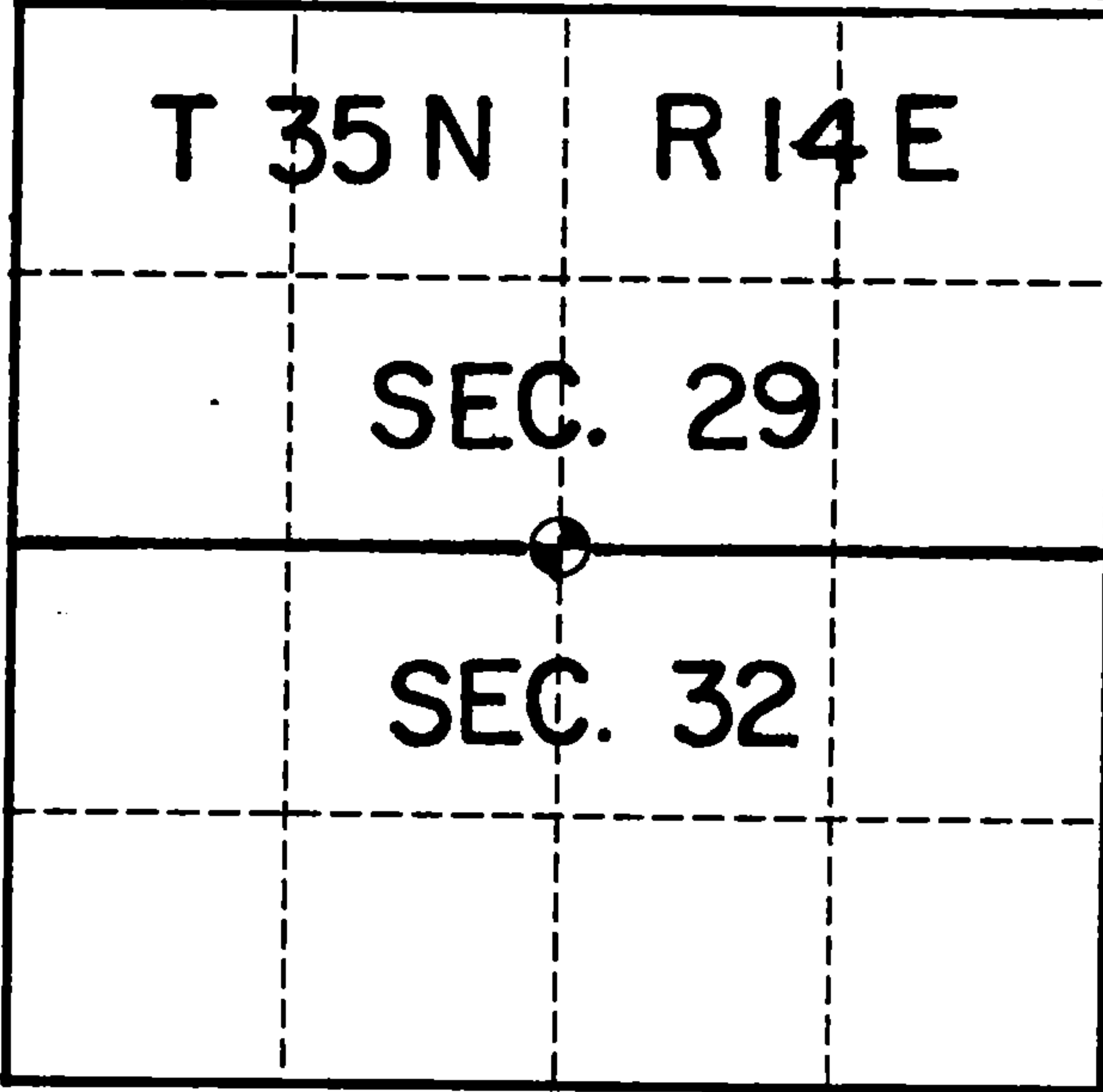

In 1859 James McBride set this corner at 40 chains and marked the following bearing trees:

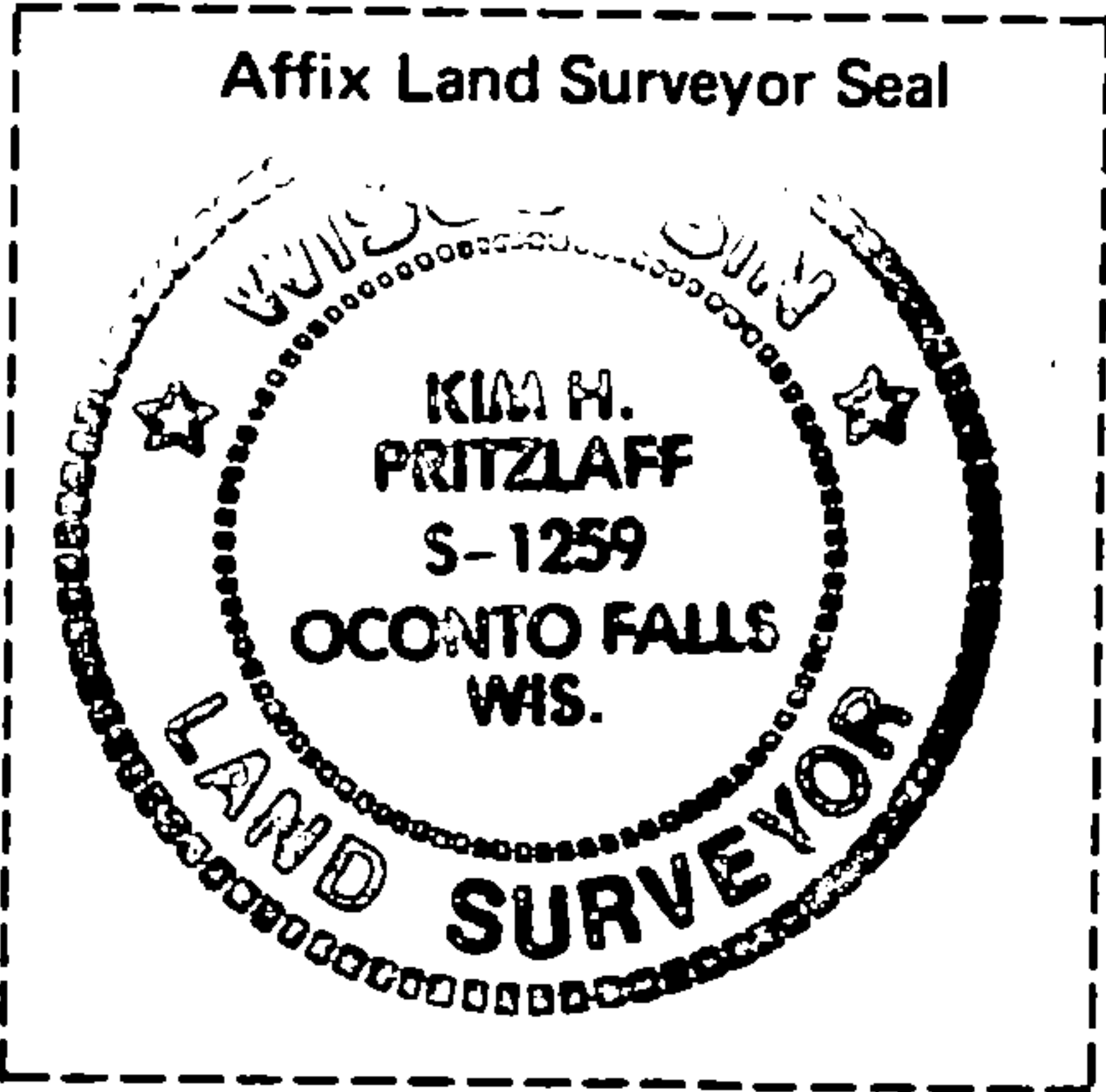
Birch 6" N39E 20 links  
Hemlock 24" S18E 31 "

At 45 chains he fell in the center of a small lake on the north end.

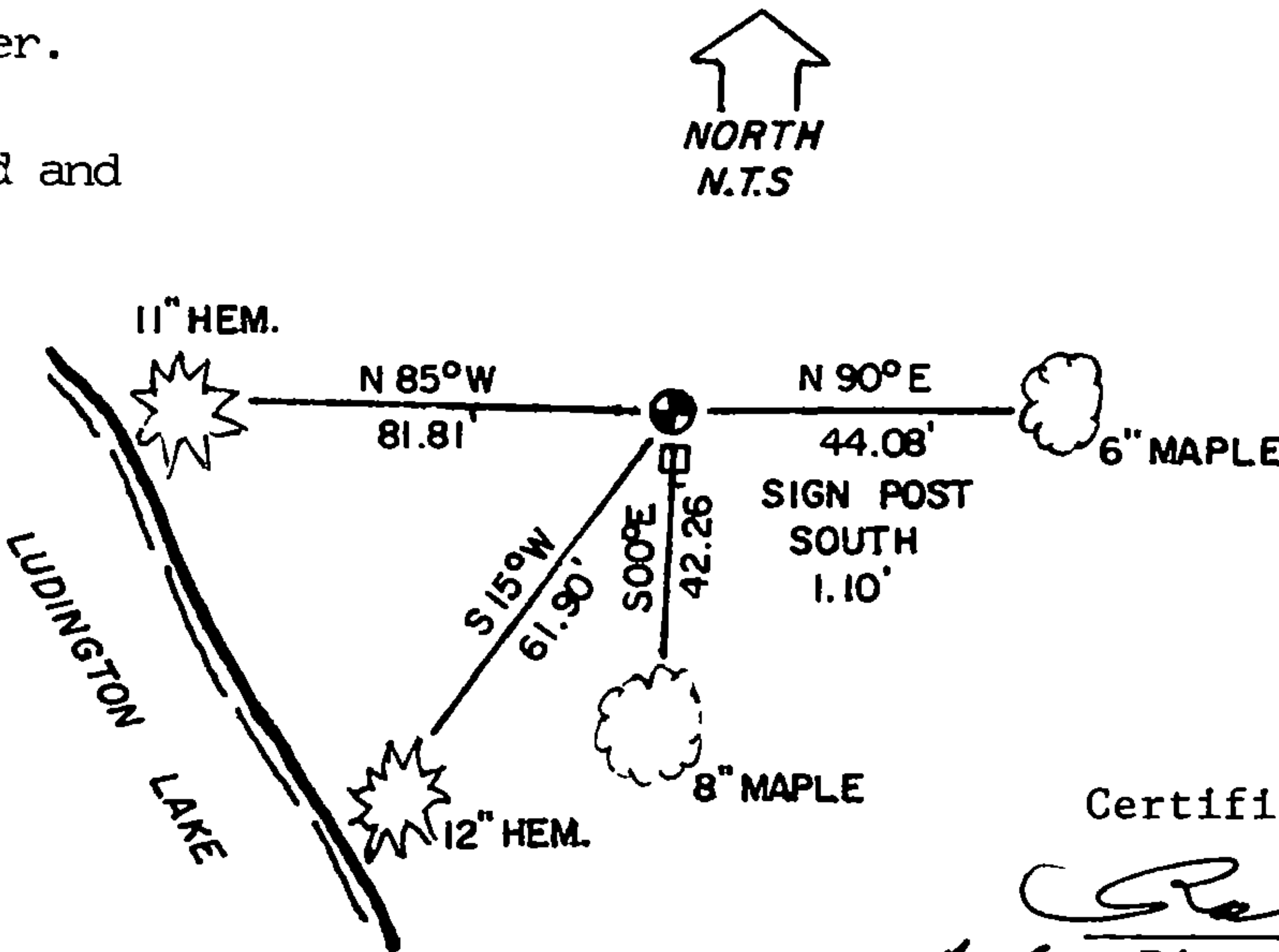
Found a 3/4" iron pipe at this corner location pointed out to me by the landowner of the NW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 32 to be the corner as set by some surveyor years ago. I found no survey record of this survey but did find a Hemlock stump remains S18E for 20 feet. The call of five chains to the west falling in the center of the lake fit the government call within a half chain. I accepted the pipe as corner perpetuation and monumented same.

In the plan view drawing below, provide reference ties to at least 4 witness monuments, or, if the location is within a municipality, to at least 2 witness monuments. (Witness monuments shall be made of concrete, natural stone, iron or other equally durable material, except wood other than bearing trees.) Also, show any material discrepancies between the corner restored or re-established and the location of any other previous corner location or occupation.

Replaced existing iron with a 2" x 36" aluminum post with cap stamped for corner. Ties are to aluminum nails driven into the tree centers which trees were blazed and scribed. Bearings are magnetic.

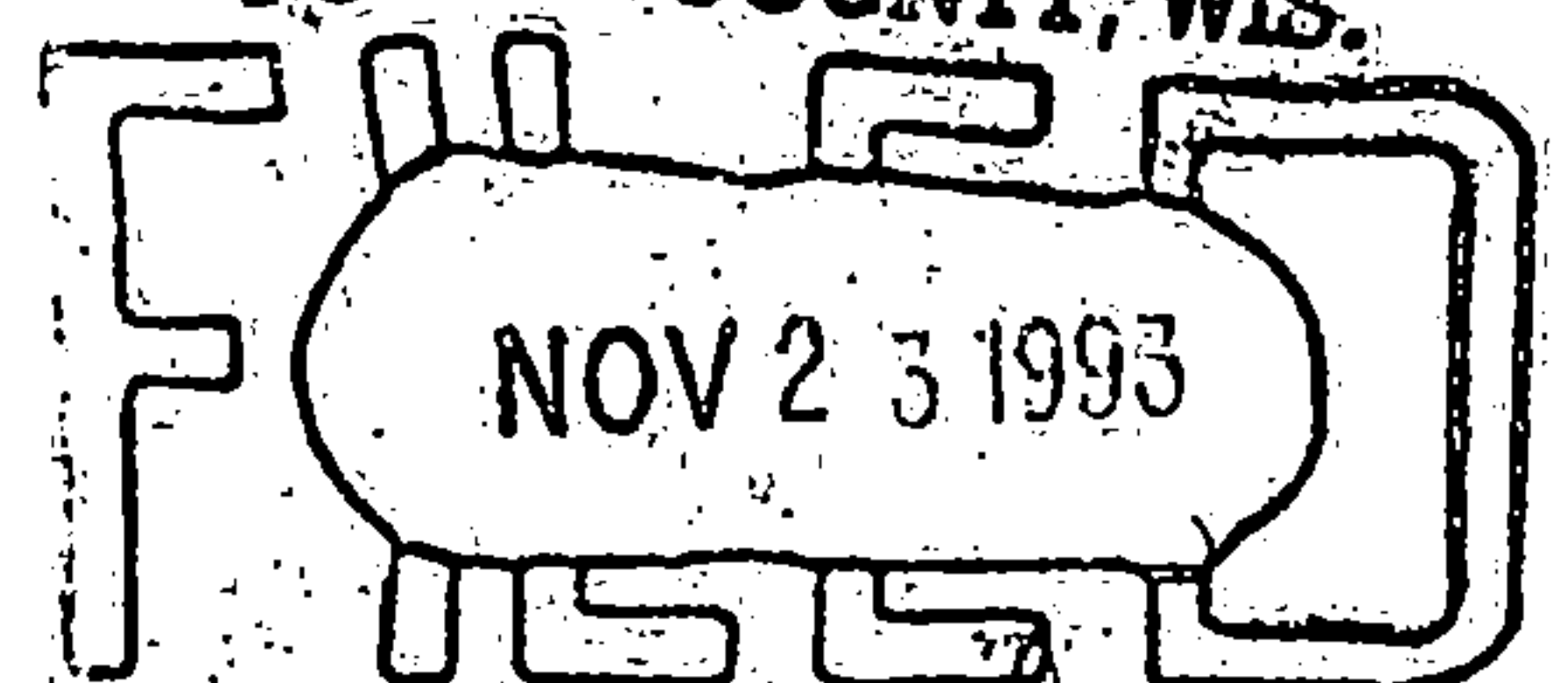
