

In 1857, Alfred Millard set township corner at 87.00 chains (fell 5.0 chains south of temporary post) with the following BTs: Hemlock, 12", N.58°E., 10 links; Hemlock, 10", S.15°E., 25 links; Sugar, 14", S.65°W., 38 links; Hemlock, 12", N.25°W., 41 links.


In 1938, C. E. Walker set a 2" brass cap.

In 1982, Milo Stefan found 2" brass cap set by Walker and made new BTs.
