


November 12, 2024 - In performing the 2024 - Forest County - "PLSS Corner Remonumentation and GPS Services" project, I found a 2.25" diameter aluminum pipe monument with a 3.25" diameter aluminum cap stamped to identify the corner. The monument is in a wet area  $\pm 100'$  east of high land, and extends  $\pm 12"$  above grade. I did not find any of Cochrane's bearing trees. I established 4 new reference monuments as shown below.




