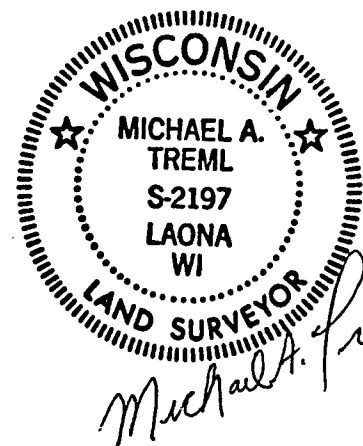
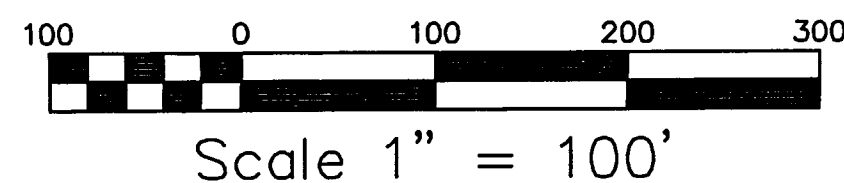


PLAT OF SURVEY

WISCONSIN



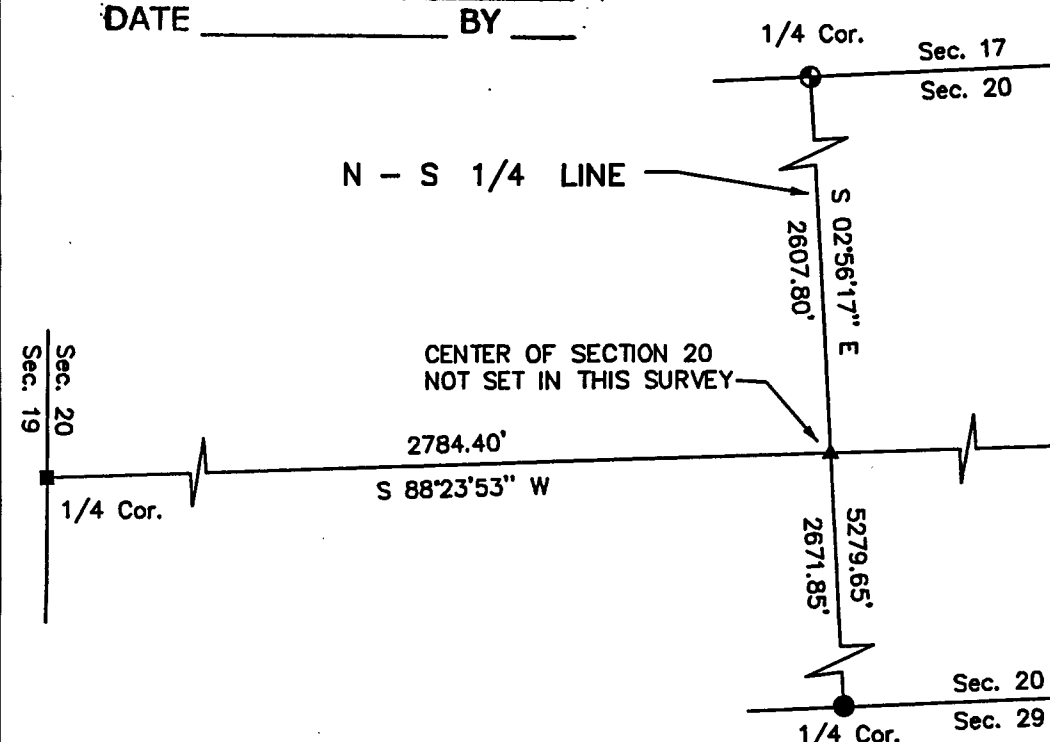
